Attention Parents/Guardians of students attending Kalkaska High School or Birch Street Elementary School:

This facility utilizes an Integrated Pest Management approach for pest control, employing non-chemical methods that include sanitation and exclusion to control pests. However, from time to time an herbicide application may be necessary to control weeds.

Please be advised that an herbicide is expected to be applied to control various weeds.

The areas to be treated are: Inside the buildings
