Essential Duties and Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Supervisory Responsibilities: This position has supervisory responsibilities.</li> <li>Ability to perform complex and technical tasks.</li> <li>Ability to function in a fast paced environment.</li> <li>Knowledge of school system's nutritional requirements and applicable local and state policies and regulations.</li> <li>Ability to communicate and collaborate with staff, school organizations (such as PTO, School Boosters, etc.) school administrators, and central office staff.</li> <li>Strong written and verbal communication skills, financial management and budget and people management.</li> <li>While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit or stand for long periods of time and occasionally must manually move, lift, carry, pull or push heavy objects or materials.</li> <li>There is occasional stooping, bending and reaching.</li> <li>The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.</li> <li>Close vision is required to perform computer related tasks</li> <li>Conducts research to improve existing practices and services.</li> <li>Establishes and maintains a marketing program including merchandising and nutrition education.</li> <li>Prepares forecasts and financial budgets and accounts for expenditures.
