Essential Duties and Responsibilities	 Instruct students 6-12 in various woodwind, brass, and percussion instruments. Serve as the lead director for the middle school and high school concert bands (jazz, symphonic), pep band, and the high school marching band. Facilitate fundraising, band recruitment, and perform administrative duties required for a successful music program. Supervise and facilitate fundraisers, summer marching band camp, concerts, parades, performance trips, and other community functions as they arise. Maintain active participation with your students in all MSBOA activities including Marching Band Expo, Concert Band Festivals, and Solo and Ensemble Festivals. Keep accurate records of student growth, instrument inventory, supply accounts, repair invoices, music purchases, budgets, etc. as necessary. Work closely with administration, staff, students, parents, and Band Booster to plan activities and gain support for various events.
